TRAGEDY ENTERS ROGERS HOME WHEN FATHER MEETS WITH ACCIDENTAL DEATH.

LEM ROGERS TAKE SONS OUT HUNTING WHILE

MOTHER IS DOING HER CHRISTMAS BAKING, AND IS KILLED WHEN YOUNGEST SON FALLS FROM FENCE AGAINST SHOTGUN---BOYS BRING BODY HOME IN AUTOMOBILE.

Lem Rogers and family were looking forward to Christmas. The day was to be a happy occasion in their home. Mr Rogers, a miner employed at the Indiana Creek Mine, has been working on every working day since the strike was settled, and the family had been promised a real old fashioned Christmas. Saturday morning Mrs Rogers was making preparations for Christmas. Pies and cakes were being baked, and she was happily engaged in performing her work and preparing for the Christmas dinner, she and her little family were to enjoy.

. Mr Rogers, not to disturb his good wife in her work, and to enjoy a little vacation with his boys, Norman, aged 11 years, and Theo, aged 13, accepted the invitation of his nephew, John Rogers, to go hunting. John furnished the car and Mr Rogers took his gun.

The hunting party drove north of town to a farm a short distance above Emison station where they decided to stop and hunt. Parking the car by the side of the road they entered the field, and began scouring the territory for game. William Riddle, father-in-law of John Rogers, accompanied them on the trip.

They came to a persimmon tree after hunting for about half an hour. It was the about 12:30 o'clock. The boys espied the persimmon tree and asked their father to wait while they gathered some of the fruit.

He stopped and was standing by the side of his nephew talking, Norman, aged 11 years, climbed upon a wire fence in order to gather some of the persimmons from a low branch of the tree. In some manner he lost his balance and fell to the ground.

In falling, the boy struck the gun, which Mr Rogers was holding his hand upon the barrel and the butt resting upon the ground. The clothing of the boy evidently hit the trigger of the weapon, causing it to be discharged.

Mr Rogers began to stagger backward, and sank slowly to the ground. "John, John save me, I am shot" he called to his nephew who stood horrified. The charge from the barrel of the gun had barely missed the nephew also.

After the one call for help Mr Rogers became quiet. His nephew leaned over him and touched him. He implored of him to speak, but the fatally injured man, was unconscious and sinking rapidly into death. He lived but a few minutes.

?? who had been witnesses of the horrible tragedy were frantic with fright and grief. They began calling for help, although they were fully a mile from the nearest farm house.

Mr Riddle, who was about 200 yards distant, heard the cries of the boys and came running toward them. He did not hear the report of the gun, due in all probability to the fact that the barrel was up against the side of Mr Rogers when it was discharged. The shot entered the right side

'-' near the short ribs, tearing an ugly jagged hole.

There was nobody near who could render help and the problem of getting the dead man back home, confronted the boys. John leaving his cousins and Mr Riddle with the body, ran across the field to where his automobile was parked, and drove to the nearest farm house. Here he told them what had happened, and requested assistance in getting the dead man in the car so they could bring him to town.

He was directed through a lane which would lead him to a spot near where the tragedy had occurred and was assured that help would come to him in a short time.

He drove down the lane, and then started to the scene of the tragedy. He had walked only a short distance when he met Mr Riddle laborously carrying the body of the dead man.

They placed the body in the automobile and drove to town. Taking the body to the Stocker Undertaking establishment to be prepared for burial.

Breaking the news to the mother, who was at home preparing for Christmas little dreaming of the sad tragedy that had entered her life, was a heart breaking task. When she was told what had occurred, she became frantic with grief, and refused to be consoled. Neighbors offered her sympathy, but the blow was so great that she could hardly bear her sorrow. And her moans and cries of grief brought tears to the eyes of the men and women who had gathered to console her.

On the table in the kitchen, where the mother had placed them, after removing them from the oven, were the pies and the cakes which she had baked while the husband and sons had gone on their hunting trip.

Mr Rogers was one of the best known coal miners in Vincennes. He was financial secretary of the Indiana Creek Local, and was a loader employed in that mine. He was aged 48 years. John

'-' Raehn, his "Buddy" who had worked with him for years, declared to a Commercial representative that "Lem had been like a brother to me; a brother could not have been more dear. He was a good man-an honest man-and his tragic death is an awful blow" and he turned his head to hide the tears that swelled up in his eyes-a big man too proud to show the grief that the death of his "buddy" had brought to him.

Besides the heart-broken widow, Mr Rogers is survived by three sons, Barthol, aged 15, Theo aged 13, and Norman, aged 11 years.

Also two brothers FS Rogers of Bicknell and Millard Rogers of Oskaloosa IA; a half brother, Daniel Rogers of Union IN; three sisters, Mrs Rosa Lesley of Indianapolis, Mrs Ellen Meize of Oaktown, and Eliza Dennis of this city.

The funeral will be held Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the First Baptist Church, conducted by the Rev J Drover Forward, pastor of the First Baptist Church. Burial will be in the Fairview Cemetery. K. of P. Lodge No 526 will have charge of the services at the grave. Indiana Creek Local will provide the pallbearers.

Started school at 5 years old in Newtonville, In. The school asked parents if she could start early because school didn't have enough enrollment. Went to many different elementary schools; Newtonville, Hazelton, and Dale, since father ministered in different churches. Graduated Reitz High School 1949, at 17 years old.

Joined the Indiana Home Demonstration Chorus, Vanderburgh County Home Economics Choir. Sang in Bloomington, IN 1964; took first place in competition. Held practices at Central Library, Evansville, IN. Sue sang Tenor. Aunt Kathryn Riggs was also in choir.
